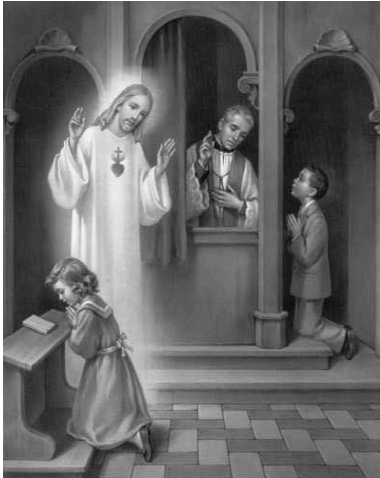

Dr. Ray Guarendi is a father, clinical psychologist, author, public speaker and radio host. His experience includes school districts, mental health centers, substance abuse programs, inpatient psychiatric centers, juvenile courts, and private practice. He has been a regular guest on national radio and television, and program psychologist for Cleveland's Morning Exchange, Pittsburgh 2-Day, and AM Indiana. He has written several books, including *Discipline That Lasts a Lifetime*, *You're a Better Parent Than You Think!*, *Back to the Family*, and his newest book, *Good Discipline, Great Teens*.



Mrs. Laura M. Berquist, a homeschooling mother of six, is founder and director of Mother of Divine Grace School. Mrs. Berquist is the author of *Designing Your Own Classical Curriculum* and editor of *The Harp and Laurel Wreath: Poetry and Dictation for the Classical Curriculum*. Based on the philosophy of the classical Trivium—grammar, logic, and rhetoric—she has developed a modern classical home school curriculum for grades K-12 that strengthens character and intellect while reinforcing virtue.



Fr. Augustine Tran was born in Saigon, Vietnam, and immigrated to America in 1974. He studied Aerospace Engineering at Notre Dame University and Georgia Tech, where he began to realize his vocation. He entered the seminary for the Archdiocese of Atlanta in 1992, and, after ordination, served at parishes in Douglasville, Decatur, and Dunwoody before studying Canon Law at the Catholic University of America. Since 2004, he has taught theology, Algebra, and Latin at Blessed Trinity Catholic High School. His conversion story, *Chosen*, has been published by Ignatius Press and is set for release in a few months.



Dr. Catherine (Katie) Moran is president of the Catholic Home School Network of America (CHSNA); member of the Round Table, a national organization of Catholic Home Schooling leaders; and founder and past leader of the Ohio Educators' Catholic Home Schooling Network.
